

# **Collagraph Online Learning/Studio Sessions**

Over the past 6 weeks, Fridays at the studio have seen a group of keen printmakers working through an online course with Sally Hirst (UK printmaker). Her informal, infectious style paired with learning about collagraphs led to many fabulous prints. We completed Part One of three modules and intend to start on Part Two in early April. And, our fellow artists, **the SSI Painters Guild**, will be hosting their annual show in the Lobby at ArtSpring during the month of March. Do take it in!


## **Off Island Shows and Opportunities**
